Scholarship History

This higher education scholarship was created in honor of June and Gary McClintock who were lifetime volunteers for Richardson Soccer Association.

June was the driving force behind RSA for so many years that she was truly thought of as the face of Richardson Soccer. She functioned in every single capacity that is possible throughout the years; coach, referee, volunteer, board member and most recently our registrar for many years until she retired in 2015. She was the world's best at recruiting coaches and volunteers and the biggest champion of recreational soccer in the area. Gary dedicated countless hours as a coach, board member and most recently as our Field Coordinator at Breckinridge Park for many years.

The Richardson Soccer community was deeply saddened when June passed away suddenly in October of 2019 and this education fund took on deeper meaning. Gary still lives in Richardson and their children are also still residents in the north Texas area.

The Scholarship

Each year, a denomination of money will be awarded to two graduating seniors who are RSA registered, active referees or active players. The scholarship must be used to help pay for their higher education room and board, tuition and/or books. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the Richardson Soccer Association Executive Board. The Richardson Soccer Association Executive Board may terminate the scholarship funds. It is the intent of the Richardson Soccer Association's Executive Board to continue this scholarship for as long as the Association is operating.

Application Information

The Richardson Soccer Association will accept scholarship applications until April 1st of each year. Winners will be announced at the RSA Spring General Membership Meeting which is generally held sometime in late April to mid-May. All applications will be reviewed by the RSA Executive Board to determine the annual winners.
